The information below covers the period from 01/07/2023 to 19/08/2023 with details provided in relation to the local priorities highlighted in the 2021-23 Local Police Plan for South Ayrshire.

 Serious and Organised Crime – (including Violence, Drug supply, Sexual Crime) 	 Violence For the reporting period, we have dealt with 1 report of a serious assault and 4 assaults. The serious assault and 1 of the assaults occurred in Main St, Prestwick involving passengers on a stagecoach bus - For the serious assault, 2 female youths have been charged. For the assault 1 adult male was arrested and held custody for court, further youths have been identified as being involved in the disturbance and will be charged. The other 3 assaults, these were minor in nature, with either no or minimal injuries sustained and enquires are ongoing. Drugs Supply Proactive work targeting drug supply is ongoing, for the reporting period there has been very few calls from the community providing information in relation to drug activity. We welcome any information in relation to drug supply. Officers have been proactive in utilising stop search powers when deemed necessary regarding drugs to target reports of drugs being used in licensed premises.
