The DPS, as you will be aware, is a statutory requirement, and similarly one which requires annual review. You'll see from the comments of HfS that we've not set an end date for comments to be submitted on the participation statement, so the date of our [Report to Council meeting of 7th December](#) and publication of the DPS on our web pages shouldn't be any cause for alarm or consternation (incidentally, the link to the web page is included in the Council Report).

Community Councils will obviously be included in engagement for LDP3. The report to Council in December was, in effect a launch of the process and establishment of a new front facing planning web page that's LDP specific. Indeed, we are about to initiate notification to all South Ayrshire Community Councils about the LDP, together with an invitation to prepare Local Place Plans – this should be before the Christmas break. The new front facing web page mentioned above, also includes an invitation for Community Councils (or other eligible constituted community groups) to prepare Local Place Plans, as per legislative requirements.

I trust the above will help to explain present processes and arrangements being put in place
